

Grace Pillow from Here and Above

The model was stitched on an 18 ct linen square with #5 pearl cotton and Caron Watercolours. Each square on the graph equals 2 by 2 linen threads. Cross Stitches are done over 2 threads. Watercolours is a variegated thread, so each cross stitch must be completed before going to the next to achieve the color variation in the model. Also, Watercolours is a 3 ply fiber. Use only one ply when stitching.

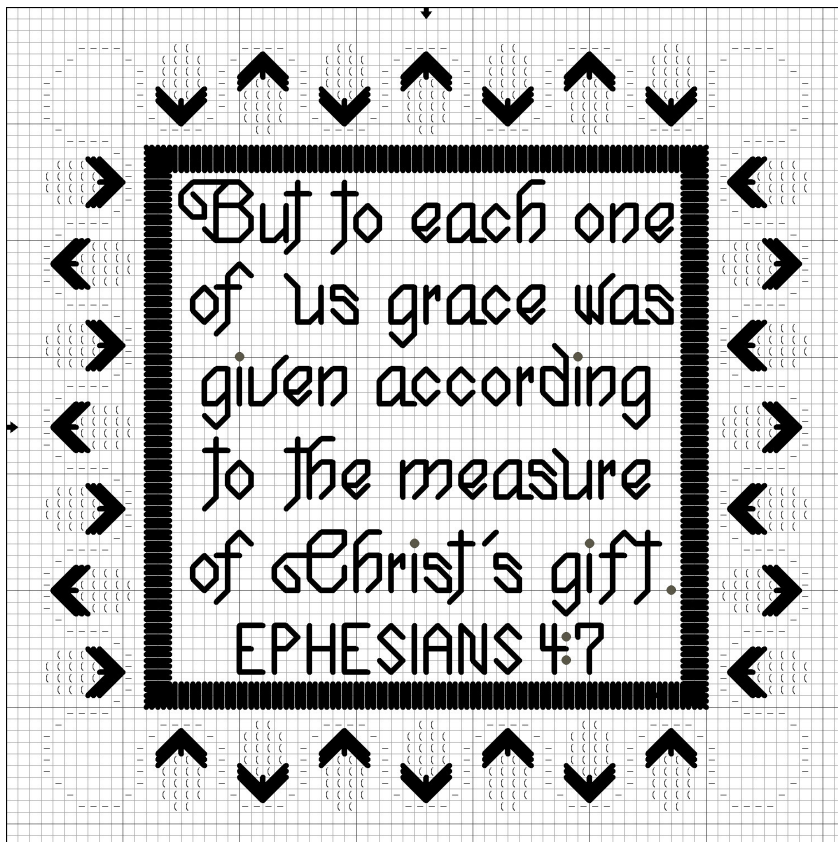
Threads:

DMC #5 Pearl Cotton

- 895 Backstitch the words
- 801 Pin Stitch (satin stitch) the border

Watercolours

- Jade "-" symbol and the straight stitches for the leaves and stems.
- Wildberries ")" symbol of the flowers/berries.



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
